 - b. In the Humanities Fine Arts building; and
- 2. Written communications, including electronic, sent or received by UM-Morris Professor Paul Z. Myers that refer to the "NorthStar," "North Star," or John Geiger; and
- 3. Written communications, including electronic, sent or received by UM-Morris Chancellor Jacqueline Johnson that refer to the "NorthStar," "North Star," or John Geiger.

If your office does not maintain these public records, please let me know who does and include the proper custodian's name and address. We will accept electronic versions of these records if they are lower in cost. We agree to pay any reasonable copying and postage fees of not more than \$200. If the cost would be greater than

this amount, please notify us. Please provide a receipt indicating the charges for each document.

We request your response within ten (10) business days of this request. If you choose to deny this request, please provide a written explanation for the denial including a reference to the specific statutory exemption(s) upon which you rely. Also, please provide all segregable portions of otherwise exempt material. Please be advised that we are prepared to pursue whatever legal remedy necessary to obtain access to the requested records.
